UConn Health Remote Access Methods

UConn Health provides multiple ways to access network resources remotely. Below are brief descriptions detailing the different methods, how they are utilized, and resources available.

- 1. **Microsoft AOVPN** Always On VPN provides full network access to <u>UConn Health managed Windows</u> <u>devices</u>. It runs automatically in the background and connects from any Internet connection.
- 2. **Pulse Secure VPN** Pulse provides full network access to <u>UConn Health managed devices</u>. For full network access it requires installing a client on the device. It can also be used to provide clientless limited access for vendors and give the ability to remote directly into servers for support purposes.
- 3. **Citrix** Citrix can provide access to a wide array of defined network resources and is required to access **EPIC**. It is unique in that it can be run on <u>personal devices</u>.
- 4. Outlook Web Access- Allows email to be accessed remotely from any device.
- 5. Site to site VPN- A dedicated VPN tunnel between us and another entity is constructed. This is a rare use case and only happens when a partner or vendor requires this.
